4-5 September 2018, HIVA-KU Leuven, Leuven (Belgium)

This workshop aims to convene established scholars and practitioners with senior experts to discuss the state of rights of migrants in the EU. A specific dataset will be developed prior to the workshop to compare the rights of different categories of migrants (intra- and non-EU migrant workers, working and non-working, asylum seekers, refugees, undocumented immigrants, ...) in the context of human rights, legal rights, social protection, right to work and social services.
