This workshop aims to bring together an interdisciplinary audience interested in these themes from both a conceptual perspective and a methodological perspective. In addition, this workshop aims to explore novel data solutions to enhance the measurement of job quality, quality of work and quality of working life such as data fusion or web-based data sources.
